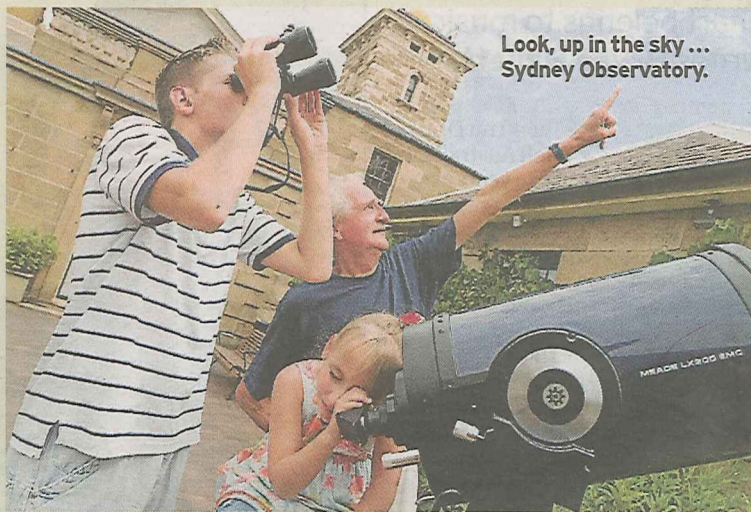
## CHILD'S PLAY
